Gaslight Pattern - Instructions for optional 1 piece centers


The original Gaslight pattern uses 5" squares for the complete assembly of the quilt top. As requested I have made some slight revisions to the pattern to accommodate using one 9 1/2" center square instead - perfect for large prints or fussy cutting! Follow the pattern as written making the small adjustments listed below.

Yardage requirements are the same for either option

Cutting: (Page 1)

From each of the 3/8 yard focus fabrics cut: (4) 4 1/2" squares, (4) 7 1/2" squares \$\xi\$ (1) 9 1/2" squares.

*For the (4) half Gaslight blocks you will only need a 5" x 9 1/2" center rectangle. All other cutting is exactly the same!



Follow all other cutting, piecing ξ trimming directions from pages 1-4. The quilt top will be assembled in a slightly different way - see below. There are only 9 rows (vs. 16) since you are piecing some rows as double row and some as single.
