Cork Mini Boxy Pouches

Cut 2 pieces of cork per bag: Small — 4 ½" x 6"

3/4" corners

Finished size 3 1/4" long x 2" wide x 2" high

Medium $-5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" $\frac{3}{4}$ " corners

Finished size: $3 \frac{1}{2}$ long x $2 \frac{1}{2}$ wide x $2 \frac{1}{2}$ high

Large - 6" x 9" I" corners

Finished size: $5 \frac{1}{2}$ long x 3" wide x $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " high

Cut your zippers approx. I'' - I 1/2'' longer than wider side of cork

Other supplies: Sewing machine with 1/4" foot, matching thread, clips, scissors, iron, ruler, rotary cutter

Optional supplies: (2) ½" x 2 ½" strips of cork for tabs

(1) ½" swivel hook

Clapper (helpful for pressing)

4 in 1 tool (has a stiletto, seam ripper and turning tool)

Feel free to experiment with different sizes using your scraps. Cutting different size corners will also give you some size options.
