

SEW MANY CREATIONS DAYBREAK CORK WALLET

Supplies:

Cork, vinyl or thin leather – this wallet doesn't work with cotton or other materials that fray

9" x 27" + 9" x 12" will make the entire wallet OR scraps work too. Non-directional cork is best!

Cut from main (9" x 27")

(1) 8" w x 10" h for main piece/zippered pocket

(2) 8" w x 7 1/2" h for flap & back pocket

Cut from accent (9" x 12")

(4) 8" w x 2" h for card pockets

Other supplies:

8" or longer plastic or nylon zipper you can sew over

Magnetic closure 1/2" or spring snap & rivet setter (both shown in video)

Matching thread

Optional (but helpful) 1/4" wide self-stick tape, non-fusible

Basic supplies like rotary cutter, ruler, seam ripper, scissors, clips, etc...

This project is domestic friendly. You will need a 1/4" foot, an 1/8" foot (I used my blind hem) and a zipper foot. This is also a great project to practice using edge coat or fabric fusion. As noted in the video, I would finish the edges as I go and then do the entire outside of the wallet at the end.
