

Emilie Mini Messenger Bag Supply List - See pattern cover for yardage & supplies

Please have all pieces cut and fused before class!

From outside fabric cut:

- *A (2) 12" W x 10" H rectangles for body
- *B (2) 11" W x 10" H rectangles for flap
- C (1) 9" W x 10" H rectangle for outside zip pocket (back)
- *D (2) 9" W x 7" H rectangles for open outside pocket (front)

From handle/tab fabric cut:

- *E (2) 4" W x WOF strips for handle Subcut into (1) 4" x 4" strip for tab & (2) 4" x 30" strips

From lining fabric cut:

- *F (2) 12" W x 10" H rectangles for body

From interfacing cut:

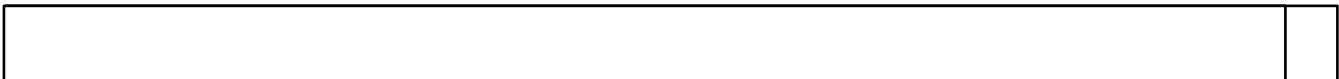
- A (2) 12" W x 10" H rectangles for outside
- B (2) 11" W x 10" H rectangles for flap
- D (1) 9" W x 7" H rectangle for front pocket
- E (1) 4" x 2" strip & (2) 4" x 30" strip for handles - see below!!!
- F (2) 12" W x 10" H rectangles for lining

From fusible fleece cut:

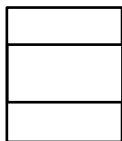
- A (2) 12" W x 10" H rectangles for outside
- B (1) 11" W x 10" H rectangles for flap front

Fuse interfacing to wrong side of pieces first then fuse fleece on top of interfacing.

For handle & tab:



Sew (2) long strips end to end to make a long single handle and fuse interfacing as shown, 2" short on one end. Tip: When you add the interfacing be sure to overlap the strips by about 1/8" - 1/4" to prevent a crease in your strap.



For tab center interfacing on tab fabric - interfacing will NOT be caught in bag seam
