W = Width of piece \iff L or H = Length or height of piece

* = Piece will have interfacing

Cutting:

From Outside Main cut:

- *A (2) 16" w x 12" h pieces for outside front \(\xi \) back
- *B (2) 5" w x 7 1/2" h strips for sides/gusset
- *C (2) 5 1/2" w x 11 1/2" h strips for outside gusset pockets

From Outside Cork Accent Fabric cut:

(See cutting diagram on page 2 to make best use of cork - you will be short if you cut out of order!)

*D (2) 16" w x $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " h for bottom front/back accent

*E (1) 5" w x 22 1/2" L piece for bag base

F (4) 11/2" w x 5 1/2" h strips for handle tabs

*G (2) 3" w x 26" long strips for handles

From Lining fabric cut:

*H (2) 16" w x 12" h pieces for lining

*I (1) 5" w x 35" L strip for side/gusset

J (2) 16" w x 12" h strips for divided pockets

K (1) 9" w x 12" h strip for inside zip pocket

L (4) 2 1/2" w x 12" L strips for recessed zipper closure

From Décor Bond Interfacing cut:

A (2) 16" w x 12" h

E (1) 5" w x 22 1/2" L

B(2)5"wx71/2"h

G(2) 3" w x 26"

C(2) 5 1/2" w x 11 1/2" h

H(2) 16" w x 12" h

D(2)161/2" w x 51/2" h

I(1)5" w x 35" L

From Fusible Fleece cut:

A (2) 16" w x 12" h

↑ Fuse interfacing first, then fuse fleece on top of interfacing

There are 2 templates included with this pattern - you will need to have them cut out before class. I like to cut mine out of cardstock, carboard or template plastic for durability.

Use your Harper Handbag pattern to cut the cork pieces accurately!
