Cork Mini Boxy Pouches by Sew Many Creations

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Cut 2 pieces of cork per bag: $Small - 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 6" (with $\frac{3}{4}$ " corners)

Finished size: $3 \frac{1}{4}$ long x 2" wide x 2" high

Medium $-5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" (with $\frac{34}{4}$ " corners) Finished size: $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " long x $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " wide x $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " high

Large -6" x 9" (with 1" corners) Finished size: $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " long x 3" wide x $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " high

Cut your zippers approx. $I'' - I \frac{1}{2}I''$ longer than wider side of cork

Other supplies: Sewing machine with 1/4" foot, matching thread, clips, scissors, iron, ruler, rotary cutter

Optional supplies mentioned in YouTube Video: (2) ½" x 2 ½" strips of cork for tabs

(1) ½" swivel hook

Clapper (helpful for pressing)

4 in 1 tool (has a stiletto, seam ripper and turning tool)

Feel free to experiment with different sizes using your scraps. Cutting different size corners will also give you some size options. This pouch only works with non-fraying fabrics such as cork & vinyl.

Step 1: Place a piece of cork right sides together with zipper along longer edge of cork. Sew 1/4" seam. Open and finger press. Place second cork piece on opposite side of zipper and repeat.

Step 2: Press cork away from zipper and topstitch 1/8" - 1/4" on each side.

Step3: Bring bottom edges of cork right side together and stitch 1/4". Bring bottom seam to center and align with zipper. Sew 1/4" along each side (refer to video).

Step 4: Cut all 4 corners as per sizes listed at top. Reinforce seam before cutting. Box each corner and trim seam allowance to 1/8" or so before turning right sides out.
