Phoebe Zip Pouches

Free pattern!

This helpful cheat sheet was created to work with the free tutorial on my channel. It is not a complete pattern.

Supplies for all 4 pouches:

Outside - (1) 18" x 26" piece of cork (no interfacing) OR
18" x 26" cotton fabric with medium weight interfacing

Lining - (1) 18" x 26" piece of cotton fabric with medium weight interfacing OR
Waterproof Canvas OR Water Resistant Canvas

Zippers:

The zippers required for this pattern can be #3 or #5 zippers. You can use premade zippers or zipper by the yard. I suggest a zipper you can cut and sew over so nylon/plastic is my preference. The amount needed will depend on which technique you choose for each pouch.

1 Yard zipper by the yard plus 4 pulls or 4 premade zippers that measure the width of each pouch or longer.

For standard/beginner/sandwich style zipper - cut 2 - 3" wider than pouch.

For curved end style - cut 2 - 3" wider than pouch. You will also need a zipper end/stopper/cork tab.

For zipper with tabs - cut 1 1/2" shorter than pouch width. Cut (2) tabs from cork 1" x 1 1/2" or from fabric cut 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

Cutting:

For each pouch cut 2 outsides & 2 linings

Large 10 1/2"W x 8"H - 1 1/2" corners

Small 7"W x 4"H - 1/2" corners

Medium 8 1/2"W x 5 1/2"H - 1" corners

Pencil Pouch 9"W x 5"H - no corners
