## Supplies:

- (2) Squares or Rectangles of cork or cotton fabric 5" or larger
- \*Cotton fabric will also need interfacing such as Pellon Decor Bond 809 or Decovil Light 525

Matching thread

## Optional supplies:

Fabric Fusion to seal cork edges
Embellishments such as ribbon, rivets, etc...



COTTON: Place fabric squares RIGHT sides together. Sew all the way 1/4" around leaving an opening for turning. Turn RSO, press & topstitch 1/8".

CORK: Place cork squares or rectangles WRONG sides together and stitch 1/8" all the way around. OPTIONAL: If you would like to seal your edges using Fabric Fusion, I would suggest doing it now after topstitching.


TO FINISH TRAY: Measure 1" - 1.5" from each corner and fold as shown below. Stitch to hold in place and create depth. You can leave corners as is, stitch down or add rivets!



Cut 2 pieces the same size, place WRONG sides together (RST for cotton) and stitch around edges 1/8" or 1/4" or both



Measure  $1'' - 1 \frac{1}{2}''$  from corners, fold to form triangle.



Mark with pins or pencil, stitch from bottom to top.









Leave corners as is, sew down, trim or add rivets! You can even embroider the inside or add a monogram.
