Fully Lined Boxy Pouches

Revised 2023 with even more info!

For each pouch cut (2) outside pieces from cork or fabric and (2) lining pieces, fabric only. You will also need interfacing for any cotton fabric pieces. When using cork outside or waterproof canvas inside, skip the interfacing on those pieces! My preferred fusible interfacing is Pellon Decor Bond 809 or Decovil Lite 525.

Seam allowance: 1/4"

Cutting

Small: 6" H x 10" W with 1" corners - Finished size 3" D x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " W x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " H Finished size for handle: 5" L x 1" W | Embroidery placement 1" from top, 3" H For two-tone outside cut 2 each top & bottom, both 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " H x 10" W

Medium: 8" H x 13" W with 1 ½" corners - Finished size $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " D x $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " W x $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " H Finished size for handle: 6" L x 1" W | Embroidery placement 2" from top, $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " H For two-tone outside cut 2 each top & bottom, both $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " H x 13" W

Large: 10" H x 15" W with 2" corners - Finished size 5" D x 9 ½" W x 4 ½"H

Finished size for handle: 8" L x 1" W | Embroidery placement 3" from top, 4"H

For two-tone outside cut 2 each top & bottom, both 5 ¼" H x 15" W

Cut your zippers approx. 2" - 3" longer than widest side of cork. My tabs (finished) measure $1"Wx 1 \frac{3}{4}" - 2"$ long. Use a plastic zipper you can sew over & cut.
